About the Cast

JAKE JOHNSON, Co-Writer/Producer/Actor ("Tim")

Jake Johnson has emerged as a captivating actor on the rise with hilarious and engaging performances on both the big and small screen. Johnson currently stars opposite Zooey Deschanel on FOX's hit comedy series "*New Girl*", as Nick Miller, a perennial 'slacker' and grumpy guy who dropped out of law school and supports himself by working as a bartender. Johnson was nominated for a 2013 Television Critics Association Award in the category of "Individual Achievement in Comedy."

Johnson most recently starred in Fox's summer box office hit LET'S BE COPS Johnson starred in the comedy alongside his NEW GIRL co-star Damon Wayans, Jr. Johnson just wrapped his second film with Joe Swanberg, DIGGING FOR FIRE. Johnson co-wrote the script with Swanberg and stars alongside Sam Rockwell, Rosemarie DeWitt and Brie Larson. The film will premiere at the 2015 Sundance Film Festival. This summer, Johnson co-star in Universal Studio's highly anticipated sequel JURASSIC WORLD with Chris Pratt. The film will be released on June 12, 2015. Johnson was recently seen in Joe Swanberg's independent film DRINKING BUDDIES in which he stars opposite Olivia Wilde, Anna Kendrick and Ron Livingston.

Johnson graduated from Tisch School of the Arts at New York University and has worked extensively in the entertainment industry as both an actor and writer. As an actor, Johnson has worked with David Mamet, Larry David, Bob Odenkirk, John Landis, Ivan Reitman, Nick Stoller, and Adam McKay. Born in Chicago, Johnson currently resides in Los Angeles.

ROSEMARIE DEWITT ("Lee")

After a series of acclaimed turns in film, television and theatre, Rosemarie DeWitt's grace, style and charm are at the heart of several highly-anticipated projects in which she collaborates with some of the industry's most honored talent. DeWitt will next be seen in the Joe Swanberg-directed DIGGING FOR FIRE, which will debut at the 2015 Sundance Film Festival. She will star as the female lead opposite Jake Johnson. Anna Kendrick, Orlando Bloom, Jenny Slate, and Sam Rockwell also star. Following DIGGING FOR FIRE, DeWitt will also star in the Tobe Hooper directed horror classic remake POLTERGEIST, which will be released on July 24, 2015.

DeWitt was last seen in Jason Reitman's MEN, WOMEN AND CHILDREN for Paramount Pictures, a film that gives a look into the modern-day frustrations that young teenagers and adults

face in today's world laden with social media and technology. DeWitt also starred alongside Adam Sandler, Emma Thompson, and Jennifer Garner. DeWitt recently appeared in Focus Features' KILL THE MESSENGER, appearing as the female lead opposite Jeremy Renner. Michael Cuesta directed this feature based on true events. DeWitt is a graduate of Hofstra University with a degree in Creative Studies, and she also studied at the Actors Center in New York.

ANNA KENDRICK ("Alicia")

Anna Kendrick has a variety of accomplishments that showcase her impressive range of talent. She was recently seen in indie flick, HAPPY CHRISTMAS, which premiered at Sundance 2014. She will next be seen this Christmas in Walt Disney Pictures' film adaptation of the musical, INTO THE WOODS, directed by Rob Marshall, where she stars as *Cinderella* opposite Meryl Streep and Johnny Depp.

Kendrick just wrapped several films slated to open next year which include DIGGING FOR FIRE, directed by Joe Swanberg (who Anna will have worked with for the third time), THE HOLLARS, opposite John Krasinski (who also directed the film), and the highly-anticipated, PITCH PERFECT 2, directed by Elizabeth Banks. She is also set to star in Max Landis' latest script, MR. RIGHT, alongside Sam Rockwell, and directed by Paco Cabeza. She was the lead in the hit comedy-musical, PITCH PERFECT. The song *Cups*, which she performed in the film has gone multi-platinum, and is one of Billboards' top songs of 2013.

Kendrick's other recent credits include, DRINKING BUDDIES, which she starred opposite Olivia Wilde and Ron Livingston, Summit Entertainment comedy-drama 50/50, with Seth Rogen and Joseph Gordon-Levitt, and David Ayer's intense crime-drama, END OF WATCH, opposite Jake Gyllenhaal. Kendrick was also in the blockbuster TWILIGHT SAGA franchise, including NEW MOON, ECLIPSE, and BREAKING DAWN PART 1.

BRIE LARSON ("Max")

Brie Larson has built an impressive career as one of the more versatile young actresses working today. She garnered numerous 2014 Best Actress award wins and nominations for her performance in SHORT TERM 12, directed by Destin Daniel Cretton. Her dramatic role as "Grace", the director of a foster care facility, earned her Best Actress wins at the Locarno Film Festival and Gotham Awards, and a Best Actress nomination at the Critics' Choice Awards. The Los Angeles Times labeled her the It Girl of the 2013 SXSW film festival with four films showing. In addition to SHORT TERM 12 (which took home the Grand Jury prize and the

Audience Award), she had supporting turns in THE SPECTACULAR NOW opposite Shailene Woodley, playing Miles Teller's seemingly perfect girlfriend, as well as DON JON, Joseph Gordon-Levitt's directorial debut, playing the cynical/ realist sister of Joseph's character. Both films were also at Sundance and SXSW film festivals.

Most recently, Larson co-starred in the Paramount film, THE GAMBLER, opposite Mark Wahlberg, which released on December 19, 2014. Up next, she will star in the film adaptation of Emma Donoghue's best-selling novel, ROOM. She will also be seen in the Judd Apatow-directed film TRAINWRECK, and DIGGING FOR FIRE, the latter of which will premiere at the 2015 Sundance Film Festival.

In addition to acting, Larson is a writer and director. Her short film, THE ARM won the prize for Best Comedic Storytelling at last year's Sundance Film Festival. The other, WEIGHTING, was in competition at this year's SXSW film festival. A native of Sacramento, Larson started studying drama at the early age of 6, as the youngest student ever to attend the American Conservatory Theater in San Francisco. Larson currently resides in Los Angeles, CA.

SAM ROCKWELL ("Ray")

Sam Rockwell has emerged as one of the most dynamic actors of his generation by continuing to take on challenging roles in both independent and studio productions. He was recently seen in Lynn Shelton's LAGGIES, opposite Keira Knightley and Chloë Grace Moretz. This romantic coming-of-age comedy follows Megan (Knightley) who reacts to her boyfriends' marriage proposal by hiding out with a new 16-year old friend Annika (Moretz) and her dad (Rockwell). Rockwell has three other films slated for release in 2015: the remake of the classic film POLTERGEIST opposite Rosemarie Dewitt; DON VERDEAN, written and directed by Jared Hess (NAPOLEON DYNAMITE), about a biblical archeologist who walks the line between faith-promoting spectacle and massive fraud; and DIGGING FOR FIRE, written and directed by Joe Swanberg (DRINKING BUDDIES), about the pleasures and pains of building a family, and maintaining the excitement of a relationship over time.

Rockwell was featured in THE WAY, WAY BACK written by the Academy Award® winning team of Nat Faxon and Jim Rash (THE DESCENDANTS), opposite Steve Carell, Toni Collette, Maya Rudolph, and Rob Corrdry. The film premiered 2013 Sundance Film Festival, and Rockwell was nominated for a 2014 Critics' Choice Award for 'Best Actor in a Comedy' for his performance.

ORLANDO BLOOM ("Ben")

Orlando Bloom was born in Canterbury, England and trained at the National Youth Theatre in London. He later earned a scholarship to study with the British American Drama Academy. Having completed his scholarship, Bloom made his feature film debut in WILDE, starring Stephen Fry and Jude Law. Bloom was next accepted to London's Guildhall School of Music and Drama where he performed in many stage productions, including PEER GYNT and TWELFTH NIGHT. Upon graduation, a then unknown Bloom was cast in the films that launched his career: Peter Jackson's Academy Award winning trilogy, THE LORD OF THE RINGS. Bloom captured the attention of international audiences and filmmakers alike as 'Legolas.'

In the summer of 2003, Bloom starred opposite Johnny Depp and Keira Knightley in the Jerry Bruckheimer-produced Disney hit, PIRATES OF THE CARIBBEAN: THE CURSE OF THE BLACK PEARL, directed by Gore Verbinski. Bloom then reprised his role as 'Will Turner' in the box office record-breaking PIRATES OF THE CARIBBEAN: DEAD MAN'S CHEST, and PIRATES OF THE CARIBBEAN: AT WORLD'S END.

In 2013, Orlando starred opposite Forest Whitaker in the closing night film of the Cannes Film Festival, Jerome Salle's ZULU. He then starred as 'Romeo' in the Broadway production of ROMEO AND JULIET, directed by David Leveaux. Orlando then reprised his role as 'Legolas' in Peter Jackson's THE HOBBIT: DESOLATION OF SMAUG, which was released in theaters on December 13th 2013. He was last seen in the final film of THE HOBBIT trilogy, THE BATTLE OF THE FIVE ARMIES, released on Wednesday, December 17th 2014.

RON LIVINGSTON ("Bob")

2014 is proving to be a busy year thus far for Ron Livingston. He has already completed principal photography on the David Foster Wallace film THE END OF THE TOUR directed by James Ponsoldt, Donald Margulies wrote the adapted screenplay and the film stars Jesse Eisenberg and Jason Segel. Also, Livingston recently wrapped production on SHANGRI-LA SUITE. He plays Elvis Presley in co-writer/director Eddie O'Keefe's story about a couple who meet and fall in love in a mental hospital and set out on a cross country road trip with the intent to murder Presley.

In 2013 Livingston co-starred in Lynn Shelton's TOUCHY FEELY with Rosemarie DeWitt, Allison Janney and Ellen Page. The film premiered in competition at the Sundance Film Festival. Additionally, his film DRINKING BUDDIES had its World Premiere at SXSW in March. Joe Swanberg directed Olivia Wilde, Anna Kendrick and Jake Johnson in the film, which released theatrically and on VOD and was a critical hit.

Livingston may be best known as the star of the cult hit OFFICE SPACE. Directed by Mike Judge and starring opposite Jennifer Aniston, the film has gone on to become one of the industry's best-selling film/DVD rentals of all time. In the film, he played a disgruntled young office worker caught up in the corporate rat race. Raised in Iowa, Livingston graduated from Marion High School and attended Yale University. He currently resides in Los Angeles.

MIKE BIRBIGLIA ("Phil")

Mike Birbiglia is a comedian, actor, and director most well-known for his feature film Sleepwalk With Me, which premiered at Sundance in 2012 and won the NEXT Audience Award. He recently joined the cast of Orange is the New Black for a recurring role in Season 3. Last year, Birbiglia appeared in THE FAULT IN OUR STARS as well as ANNIE. This summer you can see him in Judd Apatow's TRAINWRECK opposite Amy Schumer, Bill Hader, and Brie Larson.

STEVE BERG ("Paul")

Steve Berg is an actor and improviser whose credits include Joss Whedon's DR. HORRIBLE'S SING ALONG-BLO and the features YEAR OF THE DOG and GENTLEMEN BRONCOS. He was a series regular in the Fox Television pilot "WTF America" produced by Ron Howard and Brian Grazer. Other television appearances include a recurring role on the ABC sitcom "Big Day" and guest star credits on numerous shows such as "Rizzoli & Isles," "The Ghost Whisperer" and "Breaking In." He can also regularly be seen during NFL games on FOX in the "Riggle's Pick"s comedy segments. Berg is originally from Omaha, Nebraska. He studied and performed at the Second City Hollywood and is a regular on stage at the Improv Olympic West.

About the Filmmakers

JOE SWANBERG, Writer/Director/Producer

Joe Swanberg has directed many acclaimed feature films and web shows, including HANNAH TAKES THE STAIRS, DRINKING BUDDIES, HAPPY CHRISTMAS and the IFC.com series YOUNG AMERICAN BODIES. He also co-directed and acted in the breakout horror film, V/H/S, in addition to his acting work in films like YOU'RE NEXT, THE SACRAMENT and THOU WAST MILD AND LOVELY. His films have premiered at Sundance, Berlin and SXSW and regularly appear on TV and in film festivals and theaters around the world.

ALICIA VAN COUVERING, Producer

Van Couvering's first film as a producer, Lena Dunham's TINY FURNITURE, won the SXSW Film Festival in 2010 as well as accolades from the Independent Spirit Awards, Gotham Awards and more. Other credits include Joe Swanberg's DRINKING BUDDIES, with Olivia Wilde

& Anna Kendrick; Swanberg's HAPPY CHRISTMAS, which premiered at Sundance 2014; Ry Russo-Young's NOBODY WALKS, Whit Stillman's DAMSELS IN DISTRESS, Ava Warbrick's documentary STEPHANIE IN THE WATER, and Jon Watts' COP CAR, premiering at Sundance 2015. She is a contributing editor to Filmmaker Magazine and the Head of Development and Production at Epic Magazine, an adjunct professor at NYU's Tisch School of the Arts, a Creative Producing Fellow of the Sundance Institute, and in 2013 she was nominated for an Independent Spirit Award for "Producer of the Year."

BEN RICHARDSON, Director of Photography

Ben Richardson is best known for his work on the Oscar-nominated BEASTS OF THE SOUTHERN WILD – for which he won Best Cinematography at both the 2012 Sundance Film Festival and 2013 Independent Spirit Awards – and the 2014 summer hit THE FAULT IN OUR STARS. This is his third movie with Swanberg, the two having previously collaborated on DRINKING BUDDIES, and on HAPPY CHRISTMAS, which premiered at last year's Sundance. Originally from the UK, Ben spent five years in Prague, and now lives in Brooklyn.
